Monroe County Releasee Data

Population Reported: People incarcerated in 2008 who served at least 3 months in Monroe County Correctional Facility before release in either 2008 or 2009.

- The focus is on persons with whom providers can work over several months while they remain in incarceration. The intention is to direct attention to an area in which appropriate service programming may improve chances for more successful reentry to the community and for reducing recidivism.

Total number of people – 1268.
