What is the Mary Magdalene Women's Outreach Program?

We are a nonjudgmental not-for-profit program that assists women and their families who are ready to address their issues and work toward safety, self-sufficiency and a positive direction. We provide crisis intervention, counseling, assessment and referral to supportive programs for participants. The Mary Magdalene Women's Outreach Program sponsors the Women's Re-Entry Support Group at Grace Urban Ministries.

Women's Re-entry Support Group participants are welcome to participate in all our program offerings, which include lunches Tuesdays – Fridays, dinner on Tuesday night, food and clothing distribution, hygiene kits, assessment and referral services, advocacy and professional counseling services.

What is the Women's Re-Entry Support Group?

This support group is founded by women who have experienced incarceration and are ready to help themselves and others to create new pathways in their lives. Men are the majority of the incarcerated and re-entering population and receive the focus of most community services and resources. We have learned that women face unique challenges and require different supports.

Our group is participant led, with the support of co-coordinators, a formerly incarcerated woman and a professional social worker. Our group provides mentoring, support, leadership opportunities, companionship, goal setting, information and referrals about community resources, advocacy and guidance.

Through sharing and listening to each other's stories, we create a pool of resourcefulness that helps us feel less alone. We hope you will join us at our next meeting!
