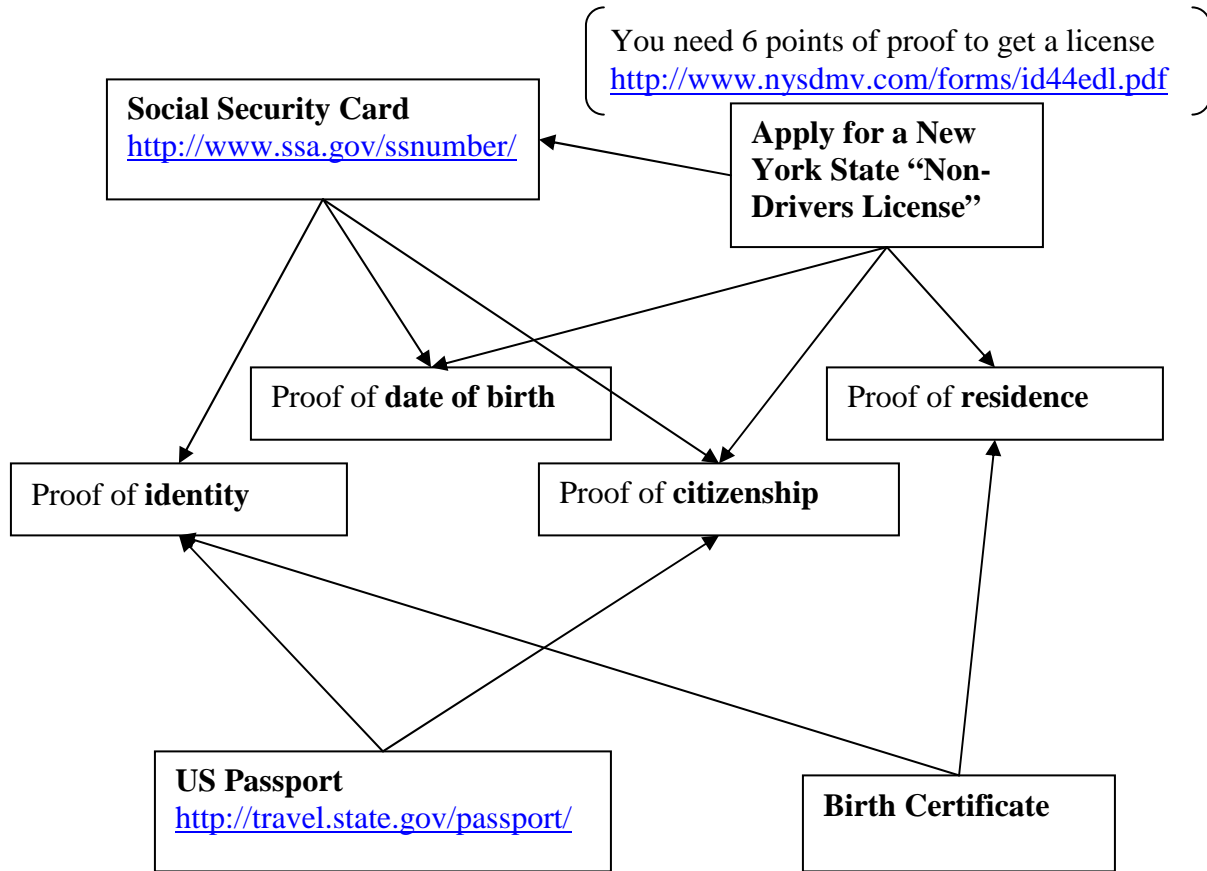


# How to Re-Establish Your Identity



## Commonly accepted proof of identity:

- Drivers or Non-Drivers license
- US Military Photo ID Card
- Certificate of Naturalization (Form N550, N570)
- Certificate of Citizenship (Form N560, N561)
- Welfare/Medicaid/NY Food Stamp Card WITH PHOTO
- Work or School ID cards WITH PHOTO and/or transcript

## Commonly accepted proof of date of birth:

- Previously issued, undamaged U.S. Passport
- Consular Report of Birth Abroad or Certification of Birth
- US Military Photo ID Card
- Certificate of Naturalization (Form N550, N570)
- Certificate of Citizenship (Form N560, N561)

## Commonly accepted proof of citizenship:

- Previously issued, undamaged U.S. Passport
- Certified birth certificate issued by the city, county or state

Consular Report of Birth Abroad or Certification of Birth  
Certificate of Naturalization (Form N550, N570)  
Certificate of Citizenship (Form N560, N561)

**Commonly accepted proof of residence:**

Current Official Mail with current address (Bills, mail from state or federal governments, etc.)  
Official Documents with current address (Car title, etc.)  
Certificate of Residence

Useful Tips: Have with you at all times any current phone bill, bank records, etc. Anything that makes you “real”.
